

Kyle's Not So Rusty Now

The Cumbria Motocross Club held the third and fourth rounds of the 2009 championship last weekend at Haverigg and we were greeted with hot weather and a well prepared track after a lot of watering had took place through Friday night and then on Saturday morning before practice ready for the hot conditions later on.

On Saturday the Junior 65 riders were up first with Kyle 'Rusty' Peebles storming to three magnificent wins ahead of fellow Cumbrian and main rival Callum Bircher. Dee Jay Walker took three thirds for third place overall.

In the Small Wheel 85's Connor Clark was the fastest rider around the sandy track and took three wins for the overall honours ahead of second placed Ben Green. Brad Todd took third after battling with Sam Braithwaite all day.

In the Big Wheel 85's Adam Sterry came out on top with all three wins ahead of Tom Moore who took three seconds for second overall. North East rider Kane Young took third place.

The Youth Open were up next with local rider Jake Gowan mastering the rough sandy taking two wins and a second for his first overall win in the Youth Open group. Will Miller salvaged second with Carlton Husband third.

In the Adult C class Ricky Gibbon took two wins and a second for the overall win ahead of Ian Ashton second and Ben Southward third.

The Adult B class was up next with Stuart Borthwick taking the overall ahead of Duncan Bell who finished second. In third place was the second race winner Andy Farr.

In the Adult A group Jamie Law took three wins ahead of Lee Tolson in second and Graham Blacklock in third.

On Sunday the track was again well prepared with the conditions a bit hotter than on Saturday.

The Junior 65's were again up first with Kyle 'Rusty' Peebles and Callum Bircher continuing their battles from the Saturday. Callum took race one but in races two and three Rusty managed to hold off Callum for the overall. Dee Jay Walker took third.

In the Small Wheel 85 group Connor Clark again topped them all but only managed two of the three wins. Brad Todd took the first race win but in the end having to settle for second overall. Sam Braithwaite took third.

In the Big Wheel 85 group Adam Sterry again took three wins to take another overall win ahead of Nathan Dixon in second and Tom Moore third.

The Youth Open were up next with Shane Tolson taking three wins after good battles with Jake Gowan, Carlton Husband and Will Miller. Jake managed to take the second overall however with Will in third and Carlton fourth after troubles in the last race.

In the Adult C class Ricky Gibbon took all three wins for the first place ahead of Ben Southward second and Chris Downham settled for third.

The Adult B class was up next with Stuart Borthwick taking all three wins ahead of Ryan Dixon in second and Gareth Goodfellow in third.

In the Adult A group Jamie Law again took three wins and the overall ahead of Jamie Jackson in second and Graham Riley in third.
