CLUB RULES 2009

In addition to the National Sporting Code and the standing regulations of the Auto-Cycle Union, the following rules apply

1. Competition Licences must be shown at signing on.
2. Riding numbers must be clearly displayed on the front and sides of each machine, using the appropriate background as specified in the ACU Standing Regulations. In adverse weather conditions, riders must wear a bib clearly displaying their riding number, if so officially requested.
3. Machines must not be ridden outside the track, run off and start area. Due to planning regulations, no machines to be running before 10am & after 6pm. any rider breaching this rule will be suspect to disciplinary action by the Clerk of the Course.
4. Lap scoring appeals must be directed to the Clerk of the Course, and the Lap Scorers decision is final.
5. Removal of track marking posts will result in disqualification
6. Riders must provide a Marshal if so requested, failure to produce a Marshal after such a request will preclude a rider from signing-on. Failure of a marshal to report for duty will result in the relevant riders disqualification.
7. To score points all riders must comply with the National Sporting Code and subject to the discretion of the Clerk of the Course on the day.
8. In the event of a tie on equal points, the rider gaining the greater number of 1st places or if this fails to decide. Then the rider gaining the greater number of 2nd places and so on down to 40th place. If this fails to decide a tie then it will be resolved by the rider scoring the highest points in the last race the riders rode together.
9. In the case of both youth and adult competition, points will be awarded in each race from 1st to 40th place as follows: 45, 42, 40, 38, 36, 35 etc.
10. In case of Youth competitions, each race will be timed as follows: Open class 14mins plus 1 lap, Senior 12mins plus 1 lap, Intermediate 10mins plus 1 lap, Junior 8mins plus 1 lap, Automatics 6mins plus one lap. These times may be altered at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
11. In the case of Adult classes at joint events the duration of each will be A Class 16mins plus 1 lap, Adult B class 12mins plus 1 lap and Adult C class 10mins plus 1 lap subject to the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

12. An event cut short before completing one full block of races will be abandoned. Otherwise all points from completed blocks of racing will stand as a result.
13. To qualify for Adult/Youth club championship a rider must start a minimum of four meetings.
ALL ROUNDS TO COUNT.
He/she must be a fully paid member.
14. Dry powder fire extinguisher (min 2kg) must be presented by each rider at scrutineering. All fire extinguishers will have a current certificate attached.
15. All bikes ridden by any class youth/adult must conform to the ACU ruling.
16. Once a rider, or parent/guardian of a rider has signed the signing on sheets, there will be no refund of entry money except at the discretion of the club.
17. At all meetings, closing time for signing on and scrutineering will be 9.30 am. There will be no exceptions.
18. To be classed as a finisher a rider must finish within 5mins of the winner crossing the finish line. Complete 50% of the winners race distance rounded up to the highest number of laps and take the chequered flag
19. No pit bikes, quads or go-peds except ridden by officials
