



## 10 TECHNICAL CONTROL

Competitors are required to produce their machines to Technical Control. When more than one motorcycle is entered they must be present to Technical Control at the same time. No competitor will be permitted to practice or race unless the Technical Official had passed clothing and machine. **From 8.00 am to 9.45 am**

## 11 SOUND CONTROL

Sound Control after a race –Any rider whose machine is above the limit (dB/A – 96 for 2 stroke machines & dB/A 94 for 4 stroke machines + 2dB/A post race tolerance) – whether it be one of the riders chosen at random or any other rider whose motorcycle is controlled/verified – may be penalized by having one minute added to his riding time in the race in question.

## 13 RACES

Each race will be timed as follows:

Adults	14 minutes plus 1 lap
Open	14 minutes plus 1 lap
BW85	12 minutes plus 1 lap
SW58	10 minutes plus 1 lap
Juniors	9 minutes plus 1 lap
Autos	6 minutes plus 1 lap

## 14 METHOD OF START

The start will be **metal drop down gate**.

Once a rider has taken his position at the start gate, he cannot change it.

A rider is deemed to be under starters orders having been called to the start line, the starter will hold up a green flag from which moment the riders are under his control, until all riders are on the start line. When all the riders are on the start line, the starter will hold up a 15 second board for a full 15 seconds. At the end of the 15 seconds, he will hold up a 5 seconds board and the gate will drop between 5 and 10 seconds after the 5 second board is shown.

No one except **RIDERS** and **OFFICIALS** shall be permitted to the area of the starting gate. Riders are allowed to groom the area behind the start gate only, provided no tools are used or outside assistance provided.

## 16 FINISH OF RACE

As per Standing Motocross Regulations 2008.

## 17 FUEL

All fuel used during an event must comply with 2008 ACU Fuel Regulations.

## 18 PADDOCK

**The riding in the paddock of any pit bikes or mini bikes is not allowed.**

## 19 MARSHAL'S

All riders must produce a Marshal. Northern Youth reserve the right to refuse entry, fine or withdraw a rider from racing. This is not negotiable. No alcohol is to be consumed on Marshal points.
