

**Northern Youth Motocross Club Ltd**  
**Rules 2010**

The ACU National Sporting Code Regulations shall apply to all events under the jurisdiction of the ACU and the following club rules.

**RULE 1**

Northern Youth Motocross Club caters for all ACU groups. Every youth rider must be signed on by a parent / guardian on the day. The Juniors will be allowed to run on the main track at the race meetings, which have been specified by the Committee at the clubs discretion.

The Centre Recorder will grade adult riders into groups. The club will run Adult A, B and C classes. Any rider riding out of class will be assessed and put into the appropriate class.

**RULE 2**

The points will be scored as follows:

**RULE 3**

**Race Results**

All riders must take the chequered flag, except when the rules of the National Sporting Code states otherwise. All riders must also have completed 50% of the winner's laps to qualify for points. All riders who have completed laps in the time allowed will score points. In the event of a tie on equal points, the highest positions on the day takes the highest place. If this situation fails then the rider scoring the highest points in the last race will resolve it as per the National Sporting code.

**RULE 4**

To enter any championship you must be a fully paid member. The overall club championship rules are as follows: All points count towards the club championship. A minimum number of 4 rounds are required to qualify. All results must be in the same group and in the event of a tie, the rider who has more Northern Youth rides will take the highest position.

**RULE 5**

Each race will be timed as follows:

Adults	14 minutes plus 1 lap
Open	14 minutes plus 1 lap
B/W 85	12 minutes plus 1 lap
S/W 85	10 minutes plus 1 lap
Juniors	9 minutes plus 1 lap
Autos	6 minutes plus 1 lap

At the Clerk of the Course's discretion

**RULE 6**

Protests will be dealt with as per the ACU National Sporting Code.

**RULE 7**

It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that his / her number is visible to the lap scorers at all times and the backgrounds comply with the ACU handbook.

**RULE 8**

The number of riders per group will be limited to the number allowed as per TCC or as per sporting code.

**RULE 9**

Should a meeting have to be cut short before one full block is completed, the whole race meeting will be abandoned. Should a race meeting be abandoned during a second or third block of races, the group who have ridden in the incomplete blocks shall count the points they have gained on the last completed block.

**RULE 10**

Should a race run more than 50% of the time limit the race will then count as in the ACU handbook.

**RULE 11**

Northern Youth Motocross Club has the right to refuse any membership or entry to the club.

**RULE 12**

All adult riders will receive either prize money or a trophy at the discretion of the club on that day.

**RULE 13**

The adult classes will be run at the discretion of the club depending on the day's entries.

**RULE 14**

Once a rider has entered the collecting area, there will be no refund given on any entry money at the clubs discretion.

**RULE 15**

Every rider must produce a valid licence at signing on as per the sporting code. Failure to do so will result in the rider having to purchase a day licence before taking part in the event.

**RULE 16**

All riders must produce a Marshall. Northern Youth reserve the right to refuse entry, fine or withdraw a rider from racing. This is not negotiable.

**RULE 17**

Northern Youth Motocross Club Ltd, reserve the right to amend or alter charges, which may be incurred beyond the clubs control, these charges will be passed on to the relevant parties.

**RULE 18**

No alcohol is to be consumed on the marshal point.

**RULE 19**

All riders must adhere to the National Sporting Code regarding riding in the paddock. Anyone caught riding in the paddock will be warned and if it continues they will be withdrawn from the racing.

**RULE 20**

All auto's will have to comply with the manufacturers specifications as per the National Sporting Code.

**RULE 21**

Abuse of officials will not be tolerated and riders will be withdrawn from the racing.
